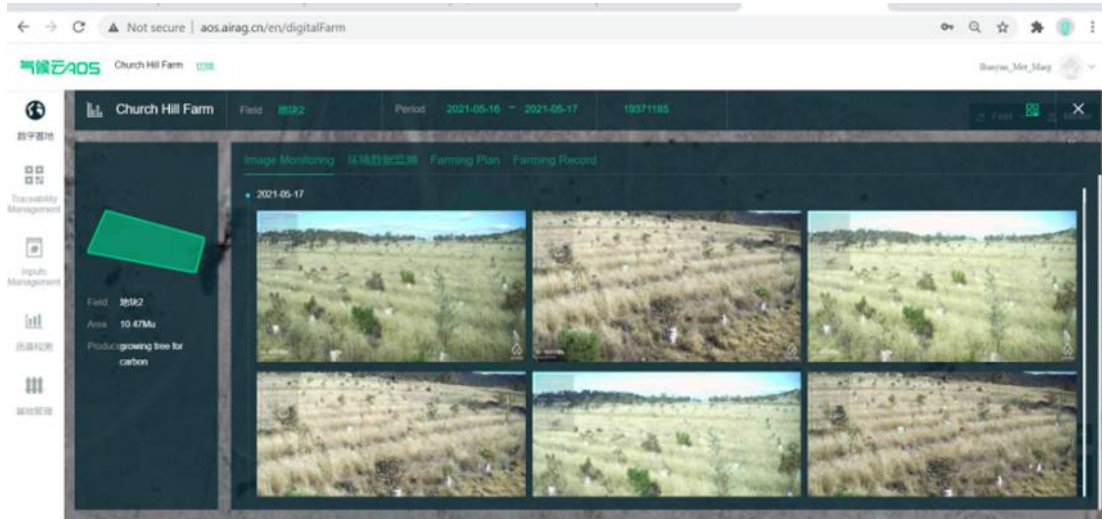
Station 6 - Weather Station

In order to understand the results of our various regeneration method trials, they first need to be put in the context of the prevailing weather conditions at the time of planting/sowing. In March 2019, we were generously provided with a remote sensing weather station by XAG Australia that allowed us to obtain weather data automatically. This instrument, which is solar-powered, records temperature, rainfall, wind speed and relative humidity. It also takes photos every 15 minutes.



The data are fed to a web platform via a telephone SIM card where they can be viewed in real time on a phone or laptop.
